October Blocks of the Month


Here are the final two blocks for Block of the Month!

They are different but still very easy. As a reminder this is the final month to turn in the YODA block.


It has been fun and I can't wait to see everyone's masterpieces at our December meeting.

Round Robin Update

We have at least seven Guild members signed up for a Round Robin! While that will make a nice group, we can accommodate as many more as would like to join the fun. If others would like to join, we just might have more groups. So, let Ava or I know if you would like to become a "Robin".

Remember that you will start with your center block. Plans are for you to have your block ready at our first in-person meeting in 2024. We will have the list of "Robins" and you will pass your block to the next "Robin". Each month you add a border (a round) to the block that you receive. Ultimately you will receive your block back that has grown in size. You are free to do whatever you like to finish your quilt. Add more or leave it as it is when it gets back to you. It's your choice. You also then have a quilt that is almost finished. Once finished, it can be a gift that you ultimately share with someone, use for yourself, or the Charity Committee would appreciate it. Again, that is all up to you.

If you think you would like to join a Row Robin, it's basically the same principle, except you would make a Row for the other "Robins" in the group.

You will be able to request/suggest things for your quilt from the other "Robins". For instance, maybe you want stripes in the fabric that make up the borders. Or perhaps you don't want a certain color. Or maybe you include fabric (that you send with your block) that you would like to be incorporated into the borders, or maybe you don't really care what is added.

This is intended to be fun, creative and hold me (Sherri I) accountable. Hopefully, you will consider joining us and having some creative fun!

So if you would like to join in, let us know you want to be included. Email Sherri Irving or Ava Wright. You can also let us know at the Guild meeting.
