

Quilt Sizes by Charity

Project Warm Embrace

- December giveaway - 45" x 60" or larger
- Quilts of any size are appreciated for distribution at other times
- Fabric bags, for children to carry their personal items

Isolette covers

- Approximately 42" by 60" – anything 39" to 42" wide and 54" to 60" long will work great
- The backside of the quilt needs to be a solid flannel

Veterans – suggested sizes by type

- For hospital use
 - Wheel chair quilts – 36" to 40" widths and lengths
 - Lap (throw) quilts – 45" to 60" wide, 60" to 75" long
- For vets to take home
 - Twin – generally 60" to 70" wide, 85" to 100" long

Twin Quilt sizes

A standard twin mattress is 39" wide and 75" long.

For sizing ideas, the following chart gives quilt measurements for specified drop (going down side of mattress) and tuck (under pillow)

Drop	Tuck	Quilt Width	Quilt Length
10"	-	59"	85"
10"	10"	59"	95"
12"	-	63"	87"
12"	10"	63"	97"
14"	-	67"	89"
14"	10"	67"	99"
