AMERICAN FLAG QUILT BLOCK TUTORIAL

$14 \frac{1}{2} X 14 1/2$



Fabric Requirements per quilt block:

- 1 Blue square 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (I am using a blue star print)
- 2 Red strips 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- 1 White strip 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- 1 White strip 2 1/2" x 14 1/2"
- 1 Red strip 2 1/2" x 14 1/2"
- 2 Background strips 2 1/2" x 14 1/2"



Sew three 8 $^{1\!\!/_2}{}''$ strips together, alternating red and white strips. Press seams toward Red

Sew two 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips together. Press seams toward red.

Optional variations:



Now here's the fun option where you can substitute a $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished (6" x 6" finished) star quilt block for the blue square if you want to!

You could use any 6" finished star block here. Go here for a <u>tutorial to</u> make a 6" x 6" finished Sawtooth Star.

Sew 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blue square to the three 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " red-white-red strip set. Press seam toward the blue square.



Press seam toward long white strip.



Sew two background 2 $^{1\!/_2''}$ x 14 $^{1\!/_2''}$ strips to the top and bottom of the flag block. Press seams toward the background strips.

This will give you a 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " quilt block.
