## AMERICAN FLAG QUILT BLOCK TUTORIAL

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141 / 2 \times 141 / 2
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Fabric Requirements per quilt block:

- 1 Blue square $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (I am using a blue star print)
- 2 Red strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 White strip $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 White strip $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 Red strip $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 Background strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


Sew three $81^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ strips together, alternating red and white strips. Press seams toward Red

Sew two $141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips together. Press seams toward red.


Now here's the fun option where you can substitute a $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished ( $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ finished) star quilt block for the blue square if you want to!

You could use any 6" finished star block here. Go here for a tutorial to make a $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ finished Sawtooth Star.

Sew $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue square to the three $81^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ red-white-red strip set. Press seam toward the blue square.


Sew bottom red-white strip set to the top red-white-red unit. Press seam toward long white strip.


Sew two background $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of the flag block. Press seams toward the background strips.

This will give you a $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ quilt block.
