FEBRUARY

Bring your quilts to be considered for display at the festival to represent our guild. NEW for this festival is that tied or tacked crazy quilts will be accepted. The quilts will be measured and other details recorded (name, date, etc.). Your quilt doesn't have to be finished—but it MUST have a hanging sleeve so plan for that!
