#### **Our First 2024 Challenge**

This year we will have 2 or 3 smaller challenges in addition to the Row by Row / Round Robin challenge. Our first challenge will coincide with January's speaker, Christine Hall Murphy from Simply Classic. She will be demonstrating purse construction. Your challenge will be to make some kind of bag, purse, tote, cosmetic bag, etc. with a zipper. It can be of any material and of any size, but must have a zipper. This project challenge will be due at the April guild meeting. Be sure to watch Christine on Zoom at our January meeting for some inspiration!

#### Round Robin and Row by Row

We've decided to wait until March to kick off the Round Robin / Row by Row challenge. We'll do two groups, one for Round Robin, one for Row by Row. So, if you haven't already signed up, there's still time. Please let Sherri Critchfield know by January 12th if you would like to join in, and which group you prefer. After that, we'll send out guidelines and tips to everyone that has signed up. You'll then have about two months to put together your kit to pass to other quilters.

We'll go for five to six months, with the exchange back to the original quilter in August or September, then the showing of finished projects in November.
